## College, Business or Vocational Students

“You can get food stamp benefits if you are a student and you are working, enrolled in an employment and training program, disabled, getting cash assistance, over the age of 50, or the parent of young children.” (California Department of Social Services)

## Documents Needed

- Adult Photo ID
- Receipts of Monthly Expenses (gas, electricity, water, etc...)
- Social Security Cards for you & other household members
- Proof of Income for the current
- Recent Bank Statements (Checking Account/Savings Account)
- Proof of child care payments (if applicable)
- Proof of child support income (if applicable)
- Birth Certificates for you & other household member
- Proof of U.S. Residency (if applicable)
- Citizenship Document/ Alien Registration Documentation
