Methodologies for Drawing Down and Sharing USDA Match

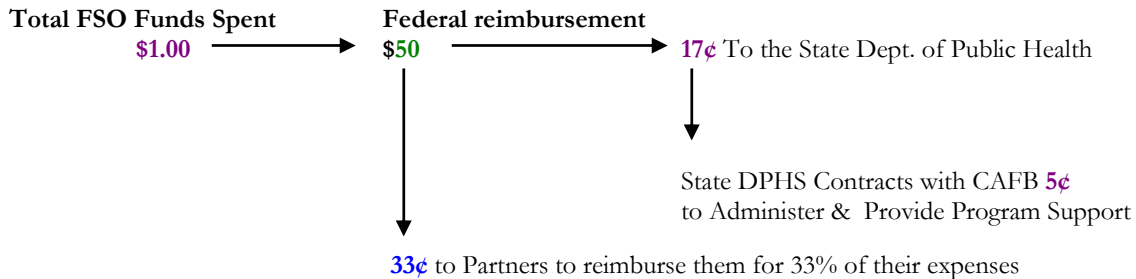


Administrative Cost Reimbursement Options

Every \$1.00 spent by a community partner generates 50¢ reimbursement from USDA. In California, there are two ways in which this match is distributed.

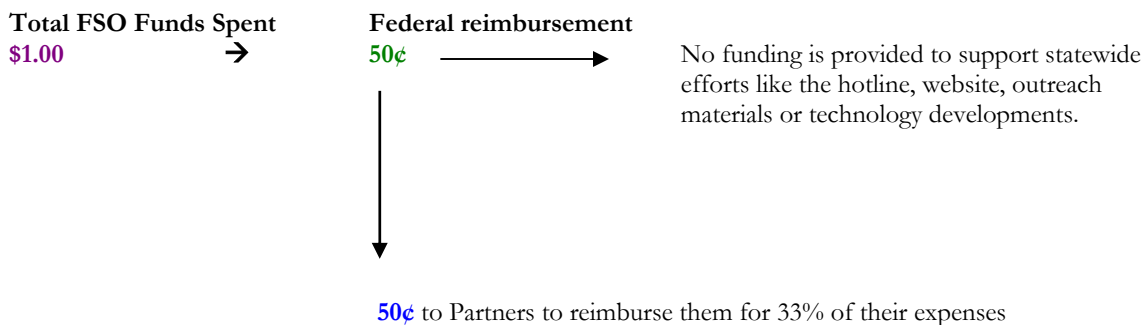
Counties Included in State Plan:

(Total FSO budget = \$1)



Counties Not In Plan: Receiving 50/50 Match Through County

(Total FSO budget = \$1.00)



Notes:

- CAFB's Food Stamp Outreach staff currently consists of: .55 FTE Program Manager, .55 FTE Contract Manager and .50 FTE Support Staff.
- The state uses their portion of the Federal reimbursement to pay for the statewide hotline (approximately \$70K per year), food stamp outreach materials and staff.
- In CA, some counties are using the 50/50 admin funds for county funded outreach using the fiscal code for NAFS enrollment.
